

1. Xi stresses building higher-level pilot free trade zones



Chinese President Xi Jinping delivered instructions on advancing the development of pilot free trade zones (FTZs) at a seminar held in Beijing on September 26 to mark the 10th anniversary of the establishment of China's first pilot FTZ. He Lifeng, a member of the


Political Bureau of the CPC Central Committee and vice premier, read out Xi's important instructions.

3. China adopts foreign state immunity law

On Sept. 1, Chinese lawmakers voted to adopt a foreign state immunity law as part of the country's efforts to step up legislation in fields related to foreign affairs.

The law, passed at a session of the National People's Congress (NPC) Standing Committee, will take effect on Jan. 1, 2024.

The law has 23 provisions and stipulates that China will move away from the absolute theory of foreign state immunity and adopt the restrictive theory of foreign state immunity.

Calling the move a "necessary adjustment" to China's sovereign immunity policy, an official of the Legislative Affairs Commission of the NPC Standing Committee told Xinhua that the new law will help protect the legitimate rights and interests of Chinese citizens and legal persons, and safeguard China's sovereignty, security and development interests.

It will also plug legal loopholes and accelerate the refinement of China's foreign affairs-related legal system, the official said.

6. China sees fundamental improvement in rivers, lakes: minister



China has seen fundamental improvement in the condition of its rivers and lakes in recent years, Water Resources Minister Li Guoying said on Sept. 11 at the opening ceremony of the 18th World Water Congress in Beijing.

China has 45,203 rivers with a river basin area of more than 50 square kilometers, and 2,865 lakes with a perennial water surface area of more than 1 square kilometer, according to the Ministry of Water Resources.

China has improved the conditions of rivers and lakes by implementing integrated protection and systematic management. For instance, some river sections that have been dry for many years, such as some sections of the Yongding River which runs through Beijing, have been restored to full flow, according to the ministry.

7. 19th Asian Games comes to an end in 'Asia's most beautiful garden'



The 19th Asian Games came to an end at the Hangzhou Olympic Sports Center Stadium in Hangzhou, east China's Zhejiang Province, on October 8.

After 15 days of competition featuring 11,830 athletes from 45 countries and regions in 481 events across 61 disciplines in 40 sports, a total of 15 world records, 37 Asian records and 170 Asian Games records were set, highlighting the incredible performances and the

efforts behind them by the participating athletes as well as the teams behind them.

China, which had 886 athletes, the second-most in Asian Games history, won a record 201 gold, 11 silver and 71 bronze medals, leading the medal standings for the 11th straight time.

Xi Jinping and Peng Liyuan warmly greeted the foreign leaders and their spouses, shook hands with them one after another and took group photos.

9. Xi announces major steps to support high-quality Belt and Road cooperation


On October 18, President Xi Jinping announced eight major steps China will take to support high-quality Belt and Road cooperation while delivering a keynote speech at the opening ceremony of the third Belt and Road Forum for International Cooperation (BRF). The eight major steps are as follows:

First, China will build a multidimensional Belt and Road connectivity network. The country will speed up high-quality development of the China-Europe Railway Express, participate in the trans-Caspian international transportation corridor, and host the China-Europe Railway Express Cooperation Forum. China will also vigorously integrate ports, shipping and trading services under the 'Silk Road Maritime,' and accelerate the building of the New International Land-Sea Trade Corridor and the Air Silk Road.

Second, China will support an open world economy. The country will establish pilot zones for Silk Road e-commerce cooperation, and enter into free trade agreements and investment protection treaties with more countries. China will also remove all restrictions on foreign investment access in the manufacturing sector, and make efforts to further advance high-standard opening up in cross-border service trade and investment, expand market access for digital and other products, and deepen reform in areas including the state-owned enterprises, digital economy, intellectual property and government procurement.

Third, China will carry out practical cooperation for the BRI. The country will promote both signature projects and "small yet smart" livelihood programs. To enhance financing support for BRI projects on the basis of market and business operation, China Development Bank and the Export-Import Bank of China will each set up a 350 billion yuan (48.75 billion U.S. dollars) financing window, and an additional 80 billion yuan will be injected into the Silk Road Fund.

Fourth, China will continue to promote green development. The country will further deepen cooperation in areas such as green infrastructure, green energy and green transportation, and step up support for the BRI International Green Development Coalition. China will implement the Green Investment Principles for the Belt and Road, and provide 100,000 training opportunities for partner countries by 2030.



Fifth, China will continue to advance scientific and technological innovation. The country will continue to implement the Belt and Road Science, Technology and Innovation Cooperation Action Plan, and hold the first Belt and Road Conference on Science and Technology Exchange. China will also increase the number of joint laboratories built with other Belt and Road parties to 100 in the next five years, and support young scientists from other countries to work on short-term programs in China. Moreover, China will put forward the Global Initiative for Artificial Intelligence (AI) Governance at this year's forum in order to increase exchanges and dialogue with other countries and jointly promote the sound, orderly and secure AI development in the world.

Sixth, China will support people-to-people exchanges. The country will host the Liangzhu Forum to enhance dialogue on civilizations with BRI partner countries. In addition to the Silk Road International League of Theaters, the Silk Road International Arts Festival, the International Alliance of Museums of the Silk Road, the Silk Road International Alliance of Art Museums, and the Silk Road International Library Alliance that have been set up, China has also launched the International Tourism Alliance of Silk Road Cities.

Seventh, China will promote integrity-based Belt and Road cooperation. Together with its cooperation partners, China will release the Achievements and Prospects of Belt and Road Integrity Building and the High-Level Principles on Belt and Road Integrity Building, and establish the Integrity and Compliance Evaluation System for Companies Involved in Belt and Road Cooperation.

Eighth, China will strengthen the institutional building for international Belt and Road cooperation. The country will work with its

BRI partner countries to strengthen the building of multilateral cooperation platforms covering energy, taxation, finance, green development, disaster reduction, anti-corruption, think tank, media, culture and other fields, and will continue to host the BRF and establish a secretariat for the Forum.

10. Chinese FM hails fruitful results of 3rd BRF



The third Belt and Road Forum for International Cooperation (BRF) marks another important milestone in the process of jointly building the Belt and Road, Chinese Foreign Minister Wang Yi said on October 18, calling the forum a "complete success."

"The most important consensus reached at this forum is to open a new stage of high-quality Belt and Road cooperation," Wang, also a member of the Political Bureau of the Communist Party of China (CPC) Central Committee, said at a press conference.


Wang noted that the new stage of cooperation is bound to create

During the forum, a total of 458 outcomes were achieved, far more than the second BRF, Wang added.

On October 10, the Chinese government issued an encompassing document to review and preview the landmark Belt and Road Initiative, marking the vision's 10th anniversary this year.

Over the past decade, BRI cooperation "has delivered real gains to participating countries," said the white paper published by State Council

Information Office titled "The Belt and Road Initiative: A Key Pillar of the Global Community of Shared Future".

The white paper is published to present the achievements of the BRI during the past 10 years, give the international community a better understanding of the value of the initiative, facilitate high-quality cooperation under it, and ultimately deliver benefits to more countries and peoples.

In March 2013, President Xi Jinping proposed the vision of a global community of shared future; and in September and October that year, he raised the initiatives of joining with others to build a Silk Road Economic Belt and a 21st- Century Maritime Silk Road.

The BRI "has contributed to the sound development of economic globalization and helped to resolve global development challenges and improve the global governance system," the white paper said.

The vision "has also opened up a new path for all humanity to realize modernization, and ensured that the efforts of building a global community of shared future are delivering real in results," it added.

12. Xi, Hichilema announce elevation of China-Zambia ties


On Sept. 15, Chinese President Xi Jinping held talks with his Zambian counterpart, Hakainde Hichilema, in Beijing.

international landscape, and the Tanzania-Zambia Railway has become a symbol of China-Africa friendship.



13. Xi meets US senators, stressing stable bilateral ties, cooperation



On October 9, Chinese President Xi Jinping met with a US congressional delegation led by Senate Majority Leader Chuck Schumer in Beijing, emphasizing the importance of a stable China-US relationship and cooperation, while rejecting the confrontational mentality and the "Thucydides trap" claim.

Chinese experts said the fact that President Xi personally received Schumer and his delegation reflects the great importance China attaches to bilateral relations, and reflects China's expectation that the US political community, through the lawmakers' visit, can gain a deeper, more objective, and rational understanding of China and Beijing's external policy.

Schumer's visit is viewed as the continuation of momentum following a slew of high-level interactions since US Secretary of State Antony Blinken visited China in June, which analysts believed will strengthen the guardrails to prevent bilateral ties from spiraling out of

control, and create an atmosphere for a possible meeting of heads of state during the APEC leaders' meeting in November.

14. China, IMF pledge further cooperation



On Sept. 1, Chinese Premier Li Qiang met with International Monetary Fund (IMF) Managing Director Kristalina Georgieva in Beijing. The two sides pledged to further strengthen cooperation.

Noting that the Chinese economy has maintained a sustained recovery trend this year, Li said China will further strengthen policy coordination and promote economic growth while sticking to reform and opening-up.

China will optimize the development environment for private enterprises, improve the scale and structure of foreign trade, and make

greater efforts to attract and utilize foreign capital, according to the premier.

With China contributing one third of the world's economic growth, Georgieva said the IMF appreciates the solid efforts taken by China to promote economic growth, and values China's leading role in helping the vulnerable as well as low- and middle-income countries develop and realizing global economic growth.

The IMF is willing to further cooperate with China, said Georgieva. She called on all parties to keep global supply chains steady and smooth to prevent fragmentation risks, saying that the IMF will work to achieve positive outcomes in the general quota review.

15. Belt and Road law-ascertainment cooperation mechanism launched in Beijing

On Sept. 6, a cooperation mechanism on foreign law ascertainment of the Belt and Road arbitration institutions was initiated at a forum held in Beijing.

It aims at providing convenience for participating institutions to ascertain the laws of each other's countries or regions in international commercial cases, said Wang Chengjie, vice chairman and secretary general of China International Economic and Trade Arbitration Commission.

The mechanism has 39 partners, including international arbitration institutions and dispute-settlement organizations from nearly 20 countries and regions worldwide, said Wang, adding that it welcomes more partners.

"We hope to work with all parties to prevent and resolve disputes in

Belt and Road trade and investments and nurture a market-oriented and law-based business environment in keeping with international standards," he said.

$16. \ \, \text{Chinese premier calls for advancing economic globalization}, \\ \text{unity within G20}$



On Sept. 9, Chinese Premier Li Qiang urged the Group of 20 (G20) members to resolutely advance economic globalization and promote unity, cooperation and inclusion within the G20.

Keeping in mind the future of humanity, Chinese President Xi Jinping has proposed the Global Development Initiative, the Global Security Initiative and the Global Civilization Initiative, Li said at the first session of the 18th G20 Summit.

Noting that humanity shares a common destiny, Li urged all countries to respect one another, seek common ground while shelving differences, and live together peacefully, adding that no one can remain

immune in the face of major crises and common challenges.

Solidarity and cooperation is the right path for the world, he added.

Leaders of G20 members, leaders of guest countries, and heads of relevant international organizations attended the session. Prime Minister Narendra Modi of India, which holds this year's G20 presidency, chaired the meeting.

Leaders at the meeting welcomed the African Union to join the G20, saying that G20 cooperation determines the direction of the world.

17. China ready to work with G77 members to open new chapter in South-South cooperation, says senior CPC official

18. China issues white paper on global community of shared future, a decade after vision proposed

Over the past decade, Xi has systematically expounded on the vision on numerous international occasions, helping the international community deepen the understanding of the vision, Wang added.



19. Wang Yi: China Stands on the Side of Peace and Human Conscience on the Question of Palestine



On October 13, Member of the Political Bureau of the CPC Central Committee and Foreign Minister Wang Yi and High Representative of the European Union for Foreign Affairs and Security Policy Josep Borrell jointly met the press after co-chairing the China-EU High-Level Strategic Dialogue.

When asked about the current Palestinian-Israeli situation, FM Wang Yi pointed out that Palestine is now in a critical situation. The ongoing conflict has caused heavy civilian casualties. The humanitarian

situation is rapidly deteriorating. China condemns all acts that harm civilians and opposes any violation of international law.

FM Wang Yi highlighted four priorities that China sees pressing given the severity of the current situation. The first is to stop the fighting as soon as possible, prevent it from spreading endlessly and avoid further deterioration of the situation. Second, it is imperative to observe the international humanitarian law, make every effort to ensure the safety of civilians, open up a humanitarian rescue and assistance passage as quickly as possible, and prevent a severe humanitarian disaster. Third, relevant countries should stay calm and exercise restraint, take an objective and just position, work for de-escalation of the conflict, and avoid causing an even bigger blow to regional and international security. Fourth, the UN should play its due role in resolving the question of Palestine. The UN Security Council needs to shoulder important responsibilities for this, build international consensus as quickly as possible and take real measures to that end.



31. Ambassador Chen Mingjian holds a media briefing on the 3rd BRF


